## Environment and Safety Are Priority at Continental Aluminum

Continental Aluminum recently conducted its annual environmental and safety training for plant employees. Since nearly all of Continental's employees have been working in the plant for more than a year, the training was basically an annual review of safety and environmental procedures.

The training included a review of Continental's Integrated Contingency Plan, which includes the Hazardous Contingency Plan, the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan, the Pollution Incident Prevention Plan, and the Spill Prevention Countermeasure Control Plan. Other topics covered in the meeting were baghouse procedures and maintenance, general housekeeping procedures, general safety awareness and related issues.



According to Will Ryan, Environmental Control Manager at Continental Aluminum, preventing pollution is the best solution. Ryan said the best way to achieve that this is to have structural and nonstructural controls in place. Structural

controls include items such as secondary containment in areas of potential spills. Non-structural controls are those such as the recent include environmental training held at Continental, routine preventative maintenance inspections and having following specific housekeeping procedures to follow.
